Betty Sue Brashier, 96, of Bulah, Texas passed away on August 21, 2025. Born Betty Sue Hassell on June 6, 1929. Betty married Donald Jones Brashier in December of 1948. 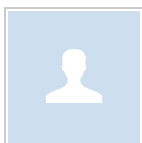
