“ Elizabeth "Carolyn" Walther, was an eyewitness to the assassination of President Kennedy. She worked as a dress cutter for Miller & Randazzo Dress Co., in the Daltex Bldg across the street from the Texas School Book Depository, at the corner of Houston and Elm Sts. On 11/22/63, she and her coworker, Pearl Springer went out to watch the Presidential motorcade from the side walk on the north side of Houston St. near the intersection with Elm. They were catty-corner from the Depository. She heard 4 shots and possibly 2 more, and reported seeing 2 men on the 6th floor of the Depository prior to the assassination, one with a rifle. Seeing the rifle, she was startled at first, but then assumed they were Secret Service or guards. She didn't ID either of them as Oswald. She was interviewed by the FBI and later did a TV interview with CBS in 1967. Thank you for speaking up, Mrs. Walther. May you rest in Peace... LG Zambanini
