James Franklin Anderson, age 90 of Lancaster, TX passed away August 1, 2014. Born 2-1-1924 in Deport, TX. Preceded in death by his parents, Thomas Uriah and Mary Wilma Bell Anderson; sister Erma Gene Deason. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Duncanville. James was raised in the Oak Cliff section of Dallas, attended John F. Peeler elementary school, and graduated from W. H. Adamson High School.
