Jean Landrum, 79, departed this world on Tuesday, September 9, 2014 after a courageous battle with pancreatic and liver cancer.

Jean was born March 4, 1935 in Dallas, Texas to Roger Harold and Carrie (Wallace) Tresp. She graduated from Wilmer Hutchins High School in May 1953 and married Henry Landrum on June 12, 1953. They lived in Wilmer almost all of their 61 years of marriage.

Jean worked at East Texas Motor Freight in Dallas until the birth of her first child in 1962. She went back to work in 1973 at Wilmer Elementary, where she worked until 1984. She then held positions at Dallas Baptist University and Texas A & M University, from which she retired in September 2007.

Jean served as the pianist for First Baptist Church in Wilmer for over 56 years, volunteering her talent to further the Lord's kingdom. She loved her church and served her Lord in many ways, touching countless lives along the way. She also cared about her community where she served on the Gilliam Memorial Library Board and the Trinity Cemetery Committee. Most of all, she loved her family and adored her three grandchildren.

Jean is survived by her husband, Henry Landrum; one son and daughter-in-law, Lawrence and Rhonda Landrum (Oak Leaf); and one daughter and son-in-law, Elizabeth (Landrum) and Dennis Scarborough (Duncanville); three grandchildren, Jennifer (Landrum) and Cory Siegler, Melissa (Landrum) and Derek Rickman, and Austin Scarborough; one brother-in-law, Lonzo Landrum;

one sister-in-law Beverly Tresp; as well as other family member and numerous friends. She was preceded in death by her parents and her brother, Roger Tresp, Jr.
