September 8, 1946 - February 25, 2022

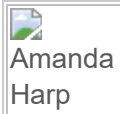

She was a very loving mother and grandmother. She loved to go fishing and camping, but her greatest joy was spending time with her grandchildren.

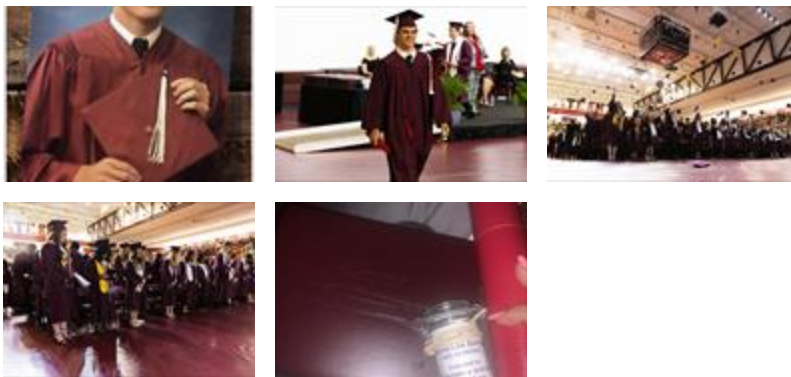
