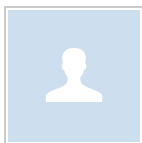

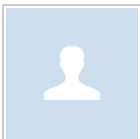


“ October 21, 2011

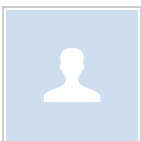
