



## Victor Cromaz

November 18, 1921 - September 3, 2014

Victor Cromaz, of Lancaster, Texas, was born November 18, 1921 in Chicago, Illinois to parents Vincent Cromaz and Mary Carlig Cromaz. He was the oldest of two children. After graduation from high school, he went to St. Louis, Missouri to become a licensed airplane mechanic. He later enlisted in the Army Air Reserves, and when the war ended, the Army called him up to active duty where he remained until his service was complete. While working at the airport in Sikeston, Missouri, he was called to work one weekend at the airport in Paducah, Kentucky. During that weekend, on a blind date, little did he know he would meet the woman who would be the apple of his eye for the next 72 years. Victor married Jewell Lindley on June 12, 1943. Victor and Jewell were blessed with four children, Danny, Eddie, Sally, and Karen. For 32 years he worked for the U.S. Post Office as a “stamp licker” (a postal clerk to most of us). The Cromaz’ were charter members of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Lancaster, Texas.

Victor is survived by his beloved wife Jewell and by his daughter Sally Murphy and her husband Pat, daughter Karen Bauswell and husband Chris, daughter in law Drena Cromaz and by his son Eddie Cromaz. He is also survived by 6 grandchildren Jamie Gorden, Sarah Gorden, Laura Coleman, Michael Cromaz, Kathryn Bauswell and Collin Bauswell. Victor was blessed with 2

great grandchildren Calle Coleman and Justin Coleman. He is preceded in death by his eldest son, Danny Cromaz and his younger brother Geno Cromaz.

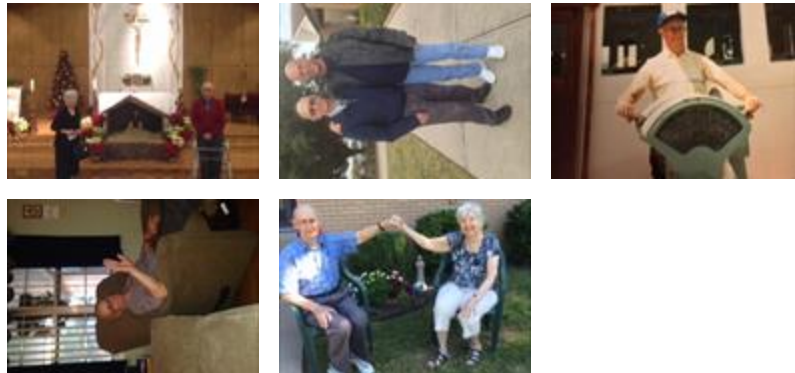
