Virginia Lee Littlefield Carter, age 96, born September 6, 1924 went to be with the Lord on June 11, 2021.

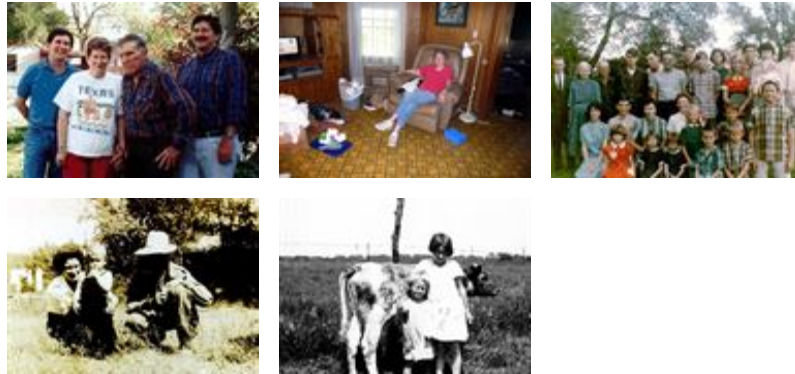
