WILLIE MAE “Billie” WOODARD passed away September 21, 2014 at Presbyterian Village North in Dallas, TX. She was born on April 16, 1923 in Hutchins, TX. She and her sister Jean lost their father and brother at an early age and grew up in the household with their mother and grandmother. Billie graduated from Wilmer-Hutchins High School in 1940 as salutatorian and she married “a boy from Wilmer” Maurice Woodard in 1947 when he returned from serving in the Navy during WWII. They raised a son and two daughters in Casa View, Dallas before moving to Louisville, KY in 1970 when Maurice was transferred by Ford Motor Co.

Billie was a stay-at-home mom but worked nine or so jobs or part-time jobs in her lifetime. After attending one year at North Texas State University, she attended business college in downtown Dallas. She took her first job as a secretary for an X-ray company and later worked for attorneys in the Labor Department . She especially loved working in Eastern High School and Central High School offices in Louisville, and Lincoln High School offices in Dallas. She enjoyed volleyball and square dancing as a young mom and later enjoyed chicken foot dominoes at CC Young Retirement Community. She enjoyed music and broke out singing after she blew out the candles at her 88th birthday party.

Billie is survived by daughter Melinda Mitchell and husband John and

daughter Carolyn Roehrig and husband Steve; four grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; six nieces and nephews; her cousins Sonny, Suzie and Jackie and her “cousin” Corinne May. She lost her son Kevin “Woody” Woodard August 2.
